

This unique program combines language learning and intercultural experiences with professional skills development. Thanks to a regular, total immersion in French culture, this program goes far beyond simply learning French as a foreign language.

WHO IS THIS PROGRAM FOR?

- Expat partners or anyone wishing to acquire a level of French
- Expat partners wishing to understand and integrate into the French labour market
- Expat partners looking for a professional opportunity to develop their skills

Any nationality, with a complete beginner, advanced beginner or intermediate level of French, is welcome to participate.

Face-to-face training, blended-learning, peer-to-peer networking

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM INCLUDE?

Depending on the participant's expectations and needs, each module can be completed individually or as part of the entire program.



MODULE 1
LEARNING FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE - 206 H

French language tests at the beginning of the training will enable us to determine each participant's linguistic level. All language learning will be based on themes related to Module 2. Both written and spoken French will be developed and aided by constant interaction between the trainers and participants. At the end of the year, participants will be given the opportunity to pass the DELF* in order to obtain a recognised level of language.

MODULE 2
FRENCH CULTURE - 97.5 H

Closely tied to learning French as a foreign language, this module allows participants to discover French culture through lectures, conferences and one-of-a-kind outings.

*DELF – official diploma issued by the French Ministry of Education to certify French competencies of foreign candidates. Four competencies are assessed: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, oral production and written production.

Example : The week of Taste

Module 1 : learning French



Food, verbs and vocabulary related to doing your grocery shopping, making a recipe, and ordering off a restaurant menu etc.

Module 2 : French culture



French gastronomy
Culinary arts (conferences and roleplays on setting a table in a culinary boutique)
Wine degustation (outing)

MODULE 3

INTERCULTURAL COMMUNICATION - 32.5 H

How can I learn to communicate better by decrypting cultural codes different to my own? How do people perceive me? How can experience feedback workshops help me go beyond my own assumptions and prejudices? Using their own personal experiences, this module will enable participants to situate their experiences within recognised, intercultural theoretical frameworks.

MODULE 4

JOB MARKET KNOWLEDGE - 35 H

This module provides an overview of the French labour market and its codes, different types of companies and their relative statutes, and types of employment contracts. It will also help participants to write a CV and cover letter, respond to a job advertisement, expand their professional networks, showcase their skills, define their professional project and pass an interview.

MODULE 5

PROFESSIONAL IMMERSION WITHIN ISIT

By investing in activities within ISIT like this, participants will have access to various ISIT campuses to share their experiences with others.

Examples:

- Prepare and facilitate a conference on a chosen theme
- Conduct conversation workshops in their language
- Tutor ISIT students according to their area of expertise
- Organise a cultural event within ISIT

Participants will be then able to develop these experiences and skills in their future careers.
